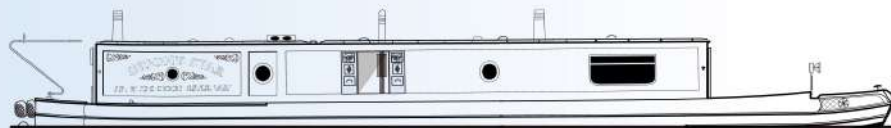

Roma is built on a 2008 shell by Colecraft, with the fit-out completed by the first owner, Richard Nelson, and launched in 2011. At 70ft in length, the boat offers a layout well suited to residential use. The accommodation is arranged in a reverse configuration, with the bedroom located in the forward cabin, a walkthrough shower room, saloon midships, and the galley and utility area positioned toward the aft, leading through to the engine room and out to the traditional stern. The shower room is fitted with a quadrant shower, composting toilet and washbasin, with hot water supplied via a Kabola diesel combi boiler. The galley and utility space include an under counter fridge, separate freezer, gas oven and grill with a separate five burner hob, and a washing machine. Dining is at the breakfast bar in the utility area. Central heating is provided by the diesel combi boiler feeding radiators and a towel rail, with additional warmth from a solid fuel stove in saloon. 230V power is from a choice of three sources – a Dometic Travel Power 3.5kW engine driven generator, a Victron Multiplus 3kW inverter/120A charger or the landline, with solar panels trickle charging the batteries.

230V circuit installed with landline connection • Galvanic isolator fitted

Independent onboard 230V power from batteries via Victron Multiplus 3kW pure sine wave inverter /charger • The inverter and a manual switch between generator & landline determine the 230V source

Dometic Travel Power engine-driven generator 3.5kW at variable rpm

ENGINE & BOW THRUSTER

Beta Marine JD3 Tug diesel • 35hp at 1,400rpm • Built by John Deere and marinised by Beta Marine • Single lever control

STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

BATTERIES & CHARGING

Twin alternators: 12V 70A alternator charges 1 x 95Ah maintenance free engine battery & 2 x 135Ah wet bow thruster batteries • 12V 100A alternator charges 4 x 120Ah maintenance free (new August 2025) cabin batteries • Charging also by Victron Multiplus 120A inverter/ charger • Trickle charging from 2 x 120W(?) solar panels

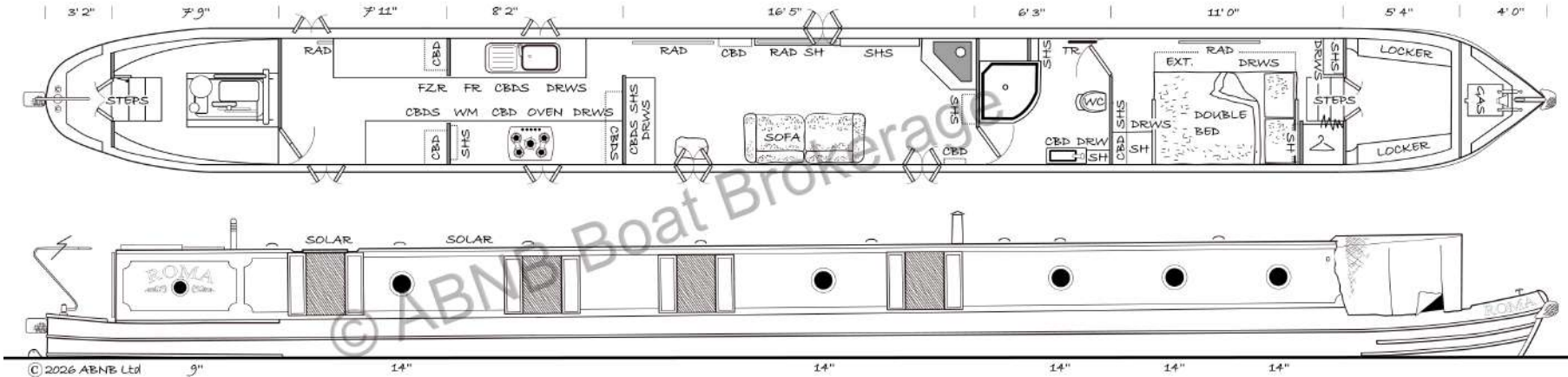

10/6/4 plating; Shell in traditional style

Fittings that are part of the shell include: Positive grip handrails and forward and aft cants • Midship rope eye

(Note plating thickness cannot be measured during ABNB visits and is based on reported information)

DECKS

Well & aft decks self draining • Well deck steel and aft deck steel with hinged steel hatch

Painted hardwood glazed cratchboard • Vinyl cratch cover with zips

FINISHES

Hull: Blue enamel coating above top guard and 2-pack epoxy to hull sides

Superstructure: Blue with blue framing • Blue aft name panel • Single cream coachlines • Light grey roof • Blue handrails • Scrolls • External paintwork is showing it's age

Roll edged laminate galley worktops with tiled splashbacks • Washbasin splashbacks tiled

Flooring: Vinyl to galley and utility room, carpet to bedroom and saloon, ceramic tiles to shower room & plywood to engine room

Insulation: Sprayed PU foam

Gas: Propane gas system with 3 x 13kg cylinders

Water: Under deck stainless steel 100 gallon (approx) water tank • Stainless steel galley sink and Seagull water filter for separate galley tap

Water Heating: Diesel Kabola (combi boiler) instantaneous water heater

Cabin Heating: Kabola HP400 **Combi diesel boiler** controlled by 7 day timer, 4 radiators, 1 towel rail • **Corner Bubble solid fuel stove**

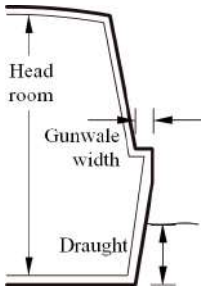
