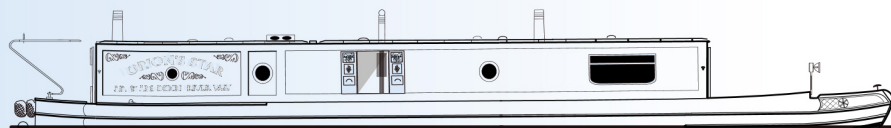

Cloud 9 is a 40ft cruiser stern narrowboat built and fitted out in 2002 by Severn Valley Boat Centre, finished in oak-faced plywood with solid oak cappings. She presents as a clean, well-kept vessel and would make an ideal starter boat for holidays, while also being capable of extended cruising or even a cosy liveaboard. The interior layout offers comfortable accommodation, including a saloon with a make-up double berth for overnight guests. The galley is a standout feature, with an attractive sweeping U-shaped one-piece worktop, gas oven and grill, separate hob, compact fridge with ice box, and a microwave. The shower room is equipped with a shower cubicle, washbasin, and a recently installed pump-out toilet with polypropylene black waste tank. Onboard electrics include a 1.8kW pure sine wave inverter, a separate 20A battery charger, and a 330Ah battery bank supported by two 215W solar panels with MPPT controller. Compact yet capable, Cloud 9 is a versatile go-anywhere narrowboat, well suited to exploring the inland waterways.

Vetus M415 diesel • 33hp at 3,000rpm • Built by Mitsubishi and marinised by Vetus • Single lever control

Standard silencer exhaust • Acoustic sound insulation • Skin tank engine cooling

STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

Engine flexibly mounted • Vetus flexible coupling • TMC 60 gearbox with 2:1 reduction • Quick release weedhatch • Remote greaser stern gear lubrication • Electric bilge pump

STEELWORK & STYLE

10/6/5/4 plating; Shell in Cruiser stern style

Fittings that are part of the shell include: Cabin edge handrails and forward cants • Fender eyes & midship rope eye

Well & cruiser decks self draining • Well deck steel and cruiser deck steel with hinged steel hatches

Single glazed aluminium framed windows & portholes

Forward doors are hardwood, glazed with a solid bulkhead • Aft door is hardwood

BATTERIES & CHARGING

Single alternator: 12V 50A alternator charges 1 x 95Ah maintenance free engine battery and charges 3 x 110Ah maintenance free cabin batteries • Charging also by Victron 12V 20A charger • Trickle charging from 2 x 215w solar panels with MPPT controller(s)

Lights: Tunnel light

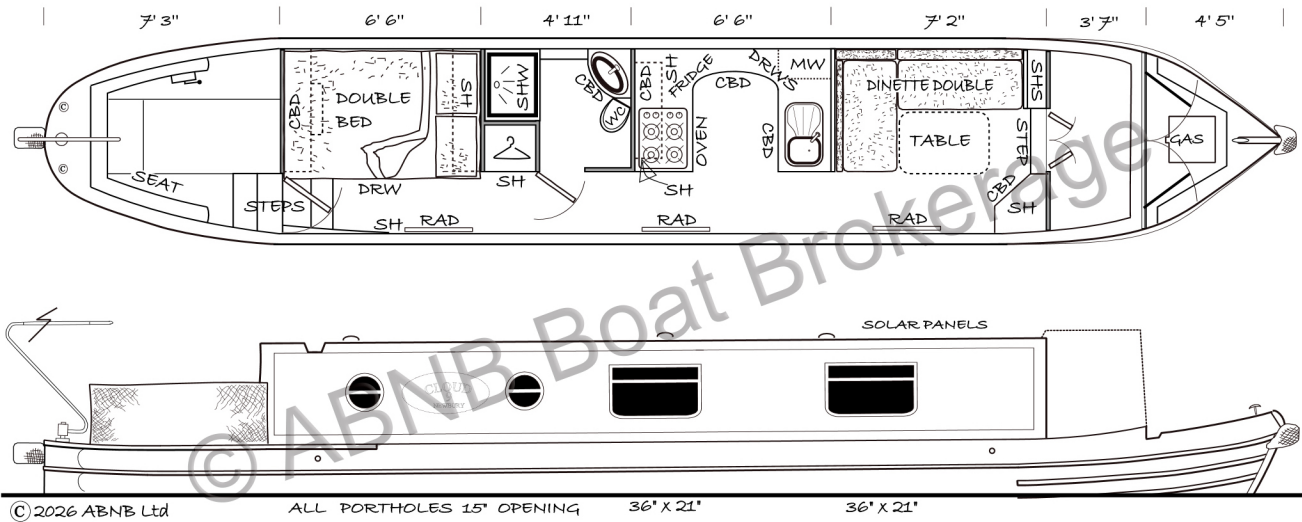

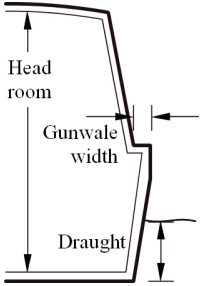
