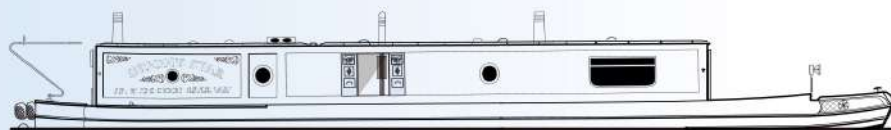

Built in 2003 by Colin Hurst (Dursley and Hurst), Meander is a 57ft 2in traditional narrowboat. The shell is from renowned builder Mike Christian, featuring a Josher style bow with replica rivets. Designed for comfortable cruising and extended stays aboard, the interior offers a practical and welcoming layout. A Pullman dinette and a single sofa bed provide flexible guest accommodation, while the main bedroom benefits from a double bed extending to an impressive 6ft wide, complemented by two wardrobes and generous storage throughout. The shower room is fitted with a pump out toilet, washbasin vanity unit and a shower cubicle. Central heating is by an Alde Compact gas boiler feeding four radiators, alongside a solid fuel stove in the saloon. Hot water is supplied via the engine or boiler. Propulsion comes from a Beta 38hp diesel engine, with a PRM 120 mechanical gearbox and an Aquadrive coupling, helping to reduce noise and vibration when underway. The exterior benefited from a professional re-paint in 2022 and is still gleaming today, and she was blacked in August 2025.

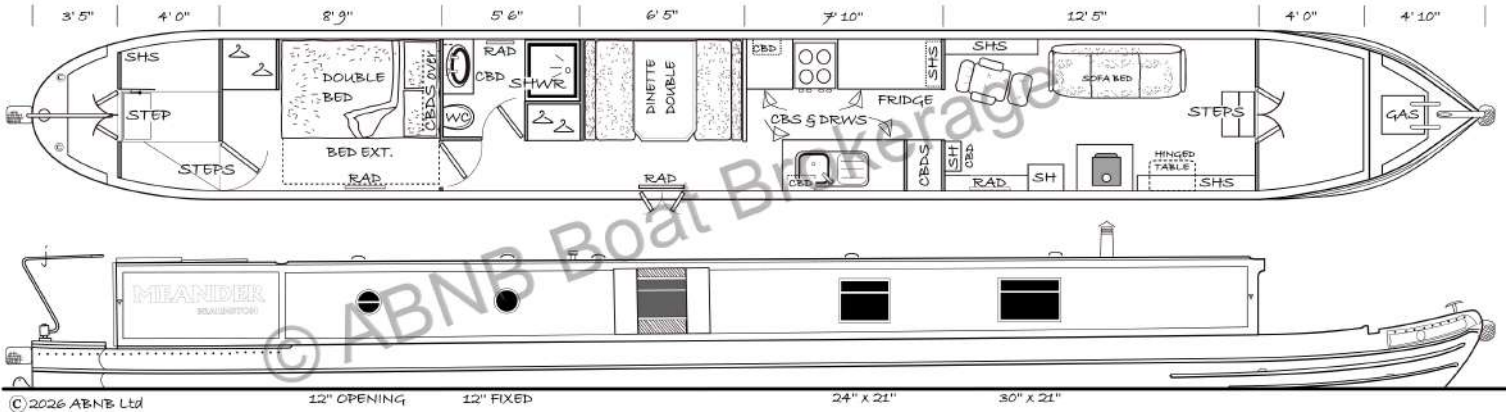
ENGINE

Beta Marine 38 diesel • 38hp at 3,000rpm • Built by Kubota and marinised by Beta Marine • Single lever control

Standard silencer exhaust • Acoustic sound insulation • Skin tank engine cooling

Instruments: Tachometer, hour meter, oil pressure gauge, temperature gauge, 2 x voltmeters

Fuel tank: 45 gallon (approx) integral stern tank • Lockable fuel filler



STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

Engine flexibly mounted • Aquadrive sophisticated combined coupling & thrust bearing • PRM 120 gearbox with 2:1 reduction • Quick release weedhatch • Remote greaser stern gear lubrication • Electric bilge pump

STEELWORK & STYLE

10/6/5/4 plating; Shell in traditional style • Enhanced by: Josher bow, hull side rivets fwd & aft

Fittings that are part of the shell include: Cabin edge handrails and forward and aft cants • Midship rope eye

Hull: Black enamel coating above top guard and bitumen to hull sides

Brasswork: Tiller & pin • **Chromework:** Chimney bands • **Painted:**, mushroom vents, fixed steps, fairleads

Caldwells single glazed gold anodised framed **windows & portholes**

Forward doors are hardwood, glazed with a solid bulkhead • Side & aft doors are steel with timber panels

FIT-OUT

Linings: Cabin sides, headlining (ceiling), hull side and bulkheads (partitions) all lined in oak plywood • Framing in dark hardwood

Hardwood edged laminate galley & washbasin worktops with laminate galley splashbacks & ceramic tiled washbasin splashbacks

Flooring: Laminate with carpet to saloon

Insulation: Cellular board

Condition of underfloor space can be checked through hatch under aft steps



SYSTEMS

Gas: Propane gas system with 3 x 13kg cylinders

Water: Under deck stainless steel 150 gallon (approx) water tank • Stainless steel galley sink

Water Heating: Calorifier heated by engine & boiler • Immersion heater boss fitted

Cabin Heating: Alde Compact 3020 HE **gas boiler** controlled by mini-programmer, 4 radiators • **Morso solid fuel stove**

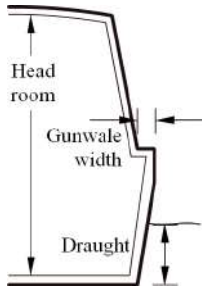
Note: Stove front is cracked and has been filled. Rear blanking plate has fallen out. Stove should not be used unless repaired.
