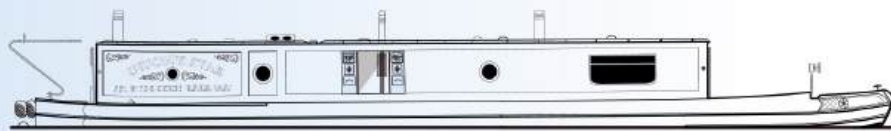

Summer Breeze is a 50ft 3in cruiser stern narrowboat, offering solid-oak craftsmanship, a comfortable layout and an excellent specification for enjoyable cruising. Built in 2002 by her first owner, who fitted her out to a remarkably high standard, she showcases expert joinery and thoughtful detailing throughout, including charming clover-leaf cut-outs in the trim. The accommodation is practical, with a spacious built-in L-shaped seating/dinette, well-equipped galley with 12V fridge, gas cooking and extending worktop, plus a shower room with a generously sized tiled shower cubicle. The permanent aft double berth extends to 4ft 9in, providing a comfortable night's sleep. Propulsion is by a Beta 38hp diesel engine, and 230V power is via the landline or Mastervolt 1kW inverter, with a Sterling 30A charger and solar panel keeping the batteries charged. Webasto diesel central heating to radiators throughout, with hot water heated by the engine, boiler or immersion. The cratch-covered well deck provides useful additional seating and storage. She is clean and tidy with a comprehensive cruising inventory, including galley equipment and crockery - you could just untie and go.

230V circuit installed with landline connection

Independent onboard 230V power from batteries via Mastervolt 1kW pure sine wave inverter • A plug system determines the 230V source

ENGINE

Beta Marine 38 diesel • 38hp at 3,000rpm • Built by Kubota and marinised by Beta Marine • Single lever control

Hospital silencer exhaust • Acoustic sound insulation • Skin tank engine cooling • Hullside vents additional cooling

Instruments: Temperature gauge, tachometer, hour meter

Fuel tank: 50 gallon (approx) integral stern tank • Lockable fuel filler

STERN GEAR & TRANSMISSION

Engine flexibly mounted • Centaflex coupling • PRIM 150 gearbox with 2:1 reduction • Quick release weedhatch • Remote greaser stern gear lubrication • Electric bilge pump

STEELWORK & STYLE

10/6/4 plating; Shell in Cruiser stern style

Fittings that are part of the shell include: Positive grip handrails and forward cants • Fender eyes & midship rope eye

DECKS

Well & cruiser decks self draining • Well deck steel and cruiser deck Hexagrip boards

Aluminium framed folding cratch cover with windows, zips & covers

Aft canvas wind dodger cover

Taff rail

FINISHES

Hull: Green enamel coating above top guard and bitumen to hull sides

Superstructure: Green • Double cream and burgundy coachlines • Cream roof • Green handrails • Signwriting and scrolls

TRAD FITTINGS

Brasswork: Navigation lights, folding steps • Painted: Mushroom vents

WINDOWS & DOORS

Single glazed aluminium (white powder coated) framed windows

Forward doors are steel with timber panels, glazed with a glazed bulkhead • Aft doors are steel with timber panels

BATTERIES & CHARGING

Twin alternators: 12V 40A alternator charges 1 x 100Ah maintenance free engine battery • 12V 100A alternator charges 3 x 100Ah maintenance free cabin batteries • Charging also by Sterling 30A charger • Trickle charging from 1 x 80(?)W solar panel

ELECTRIC FITTINGS

Lights: Tunnel light, navigation lights

Cabin lights: LED, halogen & fluorescent

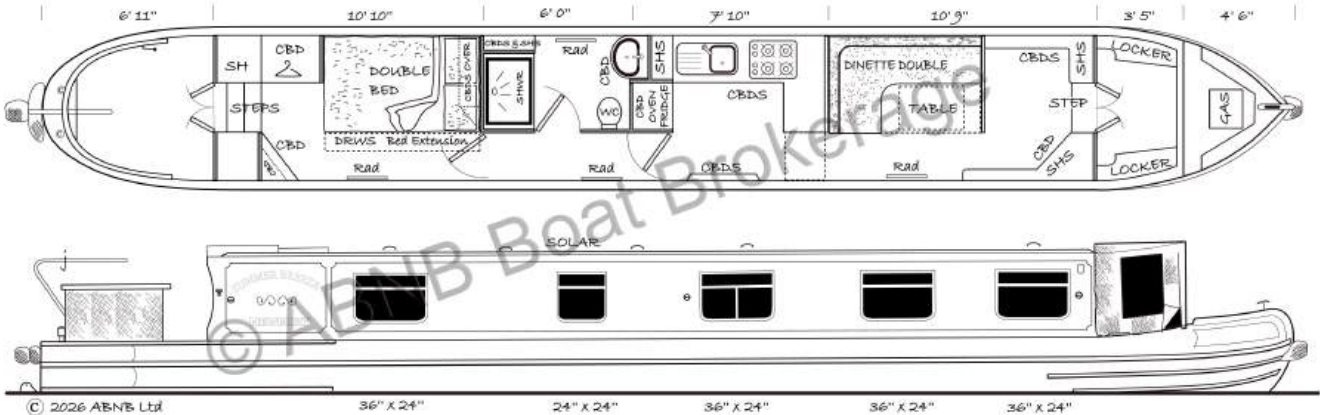

FIT-OUT

Linings: Cabin sides, headlining (ceiling), hull side and bulkheads (partitions) all lined in oak plywood • Framing in oak • **NOTE:** Some signs of typical waterstaining under windows and around aft hatch

Hardwood edge laminate galley worktops with tiled splashbacks • Washbasin splashbacks tiled

Flooring: Carpet tiles with vinyl tiles to galley and shower room

Insulation: Sprayed PU foam

Condition of underfloor space can be checked through hatch under aft steps



SYSTEMS

Gas: Propane gas system with 2 x 13kg cylinders

Water: Under deck integral 100 gallon (approx) water tank • Resin galley sink and Jabsco water filter for whole boat supply

Water Heating: Calorifier heated by engine, boiler & immersion

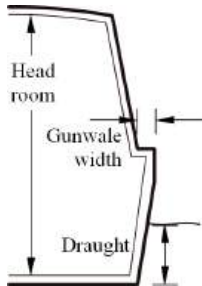
Cabin Heating: Webasto Thermo Top C **compact diesel boiler** controlled by mini timer, 4 radiators

Additional storage: well deck lockers, under aft steps, under dinette, under berth
